



Focused and ready to tackle 2019!

Happy New Year everyone!

With everyone now back on site, all our project staff have gone through a New Year briefing. These sessions provide the opportunity to focus the teams and ensure we have a safe and productive start to the year.

A number of our project staff worked some of the non-statutory days over the Christmas break, we thank them for their dedication and hard work, keeping us on track to complete our season targets. We also acknowledge the commitment of our teams who attended to storm damage on Christmas Day and Boxing Day – they showed exceptional commitment and dedication to the project.

A quick update on progress so far this season.

- We are now halfway through the earthworks season in terms of time
- Our earthworks crews have achieved 37% of the cut volumes for the season
- We have also completed 33% of the structural fills for the season
- We have moved over 1 million cubic meters of earth, and are close to reaching the 2 million mark of our 'up to 4 million' target

We are making the most of the improved weather across site and hope to welcome more in the coming months. This combined with good day-to-day planning means we are confident we can achieve our overall targets by the end of the season.

I am also pleased to announce that we will be hosting our second Project Open Day, on Sunday 31 March. This year we are delighted to be able to take you on a tour into an area of the project out of sight from the roadside, and a chance to see the big kit in action!
