Ara Tūhono - Pūhoi to Warkworth Project works set to resume with move to COVID-19 Alert Level 3

In line with the Governments move to Level 3, Ara Tūhono - Pūhoi to Warkworth Project works are set to recommence from Tuesday 28 April.

While some essential environmental, safety and traffic management works have continued during the lockdown, commuters and residents will have seen that most of the work on the site was shut down in COVID Alert Level 4. What they will now start to see is a staged increase in work across the project area between Johnstones Hill Tunnels and the Northern Connection at Warkworth. The staged increase in works is to ensure staff are well briefed, prepared and kept safe as we adapt to a new way of working in line with strict industry standards.

Work at Alert Level 3 will be different from our usual way of working. A range of new measures are being put in place, including restricted access to the site, requirements for workers to maintain physical distancing, and the use of additional protective clothing.

What are we doing?

In addition to on-going essential works activities, from Tuesday April 28, small groups of staff will be on site checking over and maintaining plant and equipment, scaffolding, and trialing new safe working procedures, particularly where close proximity working is required. In addition to this, the project will look to restart the delivery and stockpiling of aggregates and landscaping materials, and will mobilise equipment to start bridge piling works on Te Arawhiti Pua Ngahere, the Kauri Eco Viaduct near Perry Road.

The work sites will comply with mandatory requirements under Level 3 which include:

- back-to-work inductions focussed on COVID-19 hygiene awareness and safety measures
- use of PPE to follow COVID-19 hygiene protocols
- entering and leaving the workspace (contact tracing and record keeping)
- social distancing
- waste disposal, equipment use and cleaning.

All office staff and those who are not physically required to be on site will continue to work from home until further notice.





Please be assured that we are focused on ensuring the health and safety of our staff and the public during this time as we get back on with work on the project, and we request that physical distancing requirements be respected. Please do not approach our teams or enter our work sites without formal approval.
